

GRAND PARADE GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

On behalf of the citizens of the beautiful Española Valley, the 2013 Española Fiesta Council invites you to participate in the Grand Parade on [TBA] at the hour of [11:00 am]. Parade line-up will begin on Industrial Park Road and travel south on Paseo de Oñate, left on Calle Salazar, turn right and ending on Hunter Street at the old Española High School complex.

PARADE THEME: [TBA]

ENTRY FEE: \$30.00 payable to the Española Fiesta Council.

\$120.00 for all political candidates and/or representatives - NO EXCEPTIONS - All political entries will participate in a "coin-toss" to determine placement in parade line-up. Please See #10 below:

LINE-UP TIME: Beginning at 8:00 am - Industrial Park Road. **The parade will start at 11:00 am**

ENTRY DEADLINE: July 5, 2013 4:00 p.m.

1. All entries are to have a float – horseback entries, car clubs, etc. excluded.
2. Car club entries may have three (3) vehicles per application form. Car club organization name may be visible on vehicles.
3. Organizations and/or business names must be on entry floats and visible to public.
4. The Parade theme must be represented for consideration in judging for prizes.
5. Float size may not exceed twelve (12) feet in height.
6. Preaching and politicking via amplified equipment will not be tolerated.
7. Candy or other **objects may not be thrown from vehicles**. Walkers with your entry may hand these items out.
8. There will be **ZERO TOLERANCE FOR ALCOHOL** on or near any parade entry and/or parade route. You will be removed from participation and entry fee will not be refunded.
9. Please have all parade participants carpool up to the parade starting point. A limited amount of traffic will be allowed on Industrial Park Road. A maximum of two cars per float.
10. All political entries must have a float entered.
11. Any pets and/or animals taking part in the Parade must be on a leash or capable to be around people that will not cause a safety concern.
12. The Española Fiesta Council reserves the right to reject entries that violate any rules set forth above, or for any and all reasons deemed appropriate for the safety and well-being of all parade participants and spectators.
